



Hudson-Ellis Grant Opportunity

The Hudson-Ellis Fund at Blue Grass Community Foundation is accepting applications from tax-exempt, nonprofit organizations that serve Boyle County. Funding priorities for this grant opportunity include public education and services for disadvantaged and/or disabled youth and adults. Successful proposals will address community needs through projects and programs that demonstrate sustainable impact and measurable outcomes. The Hudson-Ellis competitive grantmaking program is made possible through the generosity of Lottie B. Ellis and other donors who established funds through bequests for the good of Boyle County. Grant request amount should not exceed \$10,000.

Funding Priorities:

- Economically disadvantaged youth and/or adults
- Disabled youth and/or adults
- Public Education

Eligibility:

- Organization is located in or providing services to residents of Boyle County
- Organization is classified as a nonprofit charitable organization under section 501(c)(3) of the IRS code; or publicly supported organizations such as a school district or municipality
- Organization has a complete and up-to-date GoodGiving.net portrait. GoodGiving.net is a free, searchable database that contains current, transparent information about Kentucky nonprofits. Schools and exempt government units are not eligible to have GoodGiving.net portraits, but are eligible to apply for grants. These organizations will be required to provide supporting documentation as requested within the grant application. - Organization has completed a grant report for any completed program previously funded by the Community Foundation
